

# House Numbers



It's not something a person wants to think about, but what if an emergency were to occur at your house and the police, an ambulance, or a fire truck needed to get to you in a hurry? In Riverside, believe it or not, not every house number is visible.

Did you know that 90% of house numbers are difficult to find at night, and 50% are difficult to find during the day.

Clearly readable house numbers can save precious time in an emergency. House numbers should be visible from the street at all times, day and night.

In an emergency situation, every second counts. You surely don't want emergency teams driving past your home because they can't find it, do you? You never know when you're going to need them. Please take time and go do this **RIGHT NOW**. It could save your life, or the life of someone you love.

## Ideas on how to Make your address visible:

- Post address numbers directly on your house.
- Post numbers on the alley side of the property on your fence and/or garage.
- Use house numbers that are easy to read from the street or alley.
- Use reflective or illuminated address signs that are visible at night.
- Make sure there's no vegetation that can block house numbers.
